This exciting new project was inspired by conversations we've had in school about our own school vision and values and an initiative that we've borrowed from the National Trust! As we all know, children benefit hugely from playing together with friends and family, experiencing new things, building relationships with nature, being challenged physically and having fun! None of these ideas are new but our project will offer a series of challenges for all of our children from Reception to Year 6 that will build, amongst other things, resilience, a sense of responsibility and some fabulous memories.

We have built our own version based around five core values from our school vision: creativity, challenge, curiosity, empathy and compassion.

We would like to encourage parents to look through this booklet with their child and plan which challenges they would like to complete. Some of the challenges are designed to be done exclusively at home, others are designed with school in mind.

Please take a look through the list of ideas for each year group on these pages. We are setting every child the target of completing 101 challenges between the beginning of Reception and the end of Year 6.

HOW TO GET STARTED

The target for each child is to reach at least 101 completed challenges between Reception and Year 6. Children need to complete 14 challenges in each of the years from Reception to Year 3 and 15 challenges in each of the years from Year 4 to Year 6. Children can complete more challenges each year if they wish. At the bottom of each list of challenges in every year group, you will see the WILD CARD. This is a space for any child that's had a chance to do something exceptional which isn't on our lists. The WILD CARD will count towards your total for the year.

Challenges are divided into five categories: Creativity, Challenge, Curiosity, Caring and Fun. Children need to complete at least two challenges from each category each year.

In order to recognise the achievement of the children, a special certificate and badge will be awarded to the children who complete the challenges each year. There will be a different badge for children in each year group to collect between Reception and Y6.

It is intended that the 101 things to do before you leave Bailey's Court programme will run between the beginning to Term 3 and finish at the end of Term 5 each year. The deadline for children to submit their completed record booklet will be at the end of the first week of Term 6. This must be done at home using the separate recording booklet which can be downloaded from our school website (paper copies can be requested from the school office). Teachers will assess children's achievements after the booklets have been submitted and certificates and badges will be awarded during Term 6.
