# Anti-bullying Week

This week, alongside many schools across the country, we have taken part in 'Anti-Bullying Week'. Our aim has been to help all of our children answer three particular questions:

-What is bullying? -What bullying is not? -What can you do to stop bullying?

The first two questions seem very obvious, but we often find there is confusion about the word bullying. We define it as follows:

#### **Bullying is:**

-When one child or a group of children, keeps on trying to upset or hurt another person -Done on purpose, over and over again

#### Bullying is not:

-When you have an argument or fall out with someone, or when you say something unkind to someone once when you are angry. This is, of course unacceptable but it is not what we call bullying

#### To stop bullying:

-You must tell someone you trust -Don't be a bystander – if you see bullying, tell someone!

The week will comprise of a number of assemblies for both Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 about this, plus classroom activities to reinforce these messages. These activities will focus on a range of themes including the different types of bullying (including cyber bullying), how bullying can make people feel and why people might become bullies.

We ask the children to tell someone if they either witness bullying or they feel they are being bullied. If you have a concern about this, please do approach your child's class teacher immediately: we would not want any child coming into school feeling unhappy or unsafe.
